With its multiple varieties, "gemischt" or field blend style planting provided stability in terms of yield and quality while making the vineyards less vulnerable to bad weather, diseases and pests. Gemischter Satz is a very special field blend, containing at least three grape varieties. These varieties are not only grown together in the same vineyard but harvested and fermented together. Using this method, we're able to take advantage of the special characteristics of each grape and unify them in one bottle.
