PRODUCT NOTES

After developing a passion for Pinot Noir in viticulture school, Alex Zahel took the opportunity to re-plant a family vineyard with the small-berry, Burgundian clone 115,114 in his early years as a winemaker. 18 years later, single vineyard Sätzen has proven itself as a prime location for the varietal with its mineral-rich Dolomite limestone soil structure and stable, cool microclimate.

Hand-harvest; 50% left in whole
