ABOUT THIS WINERY

Massaya means twilight in Arabic. In Tanaïl, when the sun goes down, the sky turns purple. The vineyard is 1000 meters above sea level and enjoys an ideal climate. We do not know about frost or diseases of the vine.

The wine has been a Franco-Lebanese co-production since 1992. The partners are: Dominique Hébrard, owner of Bellefont-Belcier, Daniel and Frédéric Brunier of Vieux Télégraphe, Sami and Ramzi Ghosn from Tanaïl.

TASTING NOTES

Arak works particularly well with the mezze dishes that include parsley, raw tomatoes, lemon, mint, and garlic – flavors that are sometimes harder to match with wine.

PRODUCT NOTES

Arak has a beguiling aniseed flavor and freshness that cleanses the palate and aids digestion. It is often served as an aperitif and then as the perfect accompaniment to a classic selection of mezze, the array of dishes with contrasting aromas that starts many lunchtime or evening meals in Lebanon.
