



TASTING NOTES

 $\label{eq:eq:energy} \textbf{Eye: An intense and brilliant robe, with ruby red reflections.}$

Nose: Les Jardins Rouge expresses very fruity aromas of red fruits, blackcurrant or black cherry.

Palate: The mouth is rich, dense; one finds there the aromas of red fruits raised in the nose. At the end of the mouth, there is a nice length with silky tannins.

PRODUCT NOTES

Grown on clay-limestone soils, Loudenne les Jardins Rouge reflects the subtle blend of Merlot with a small portion of Cabernet Sauvignon.
