ABOUT THIS WINERY

In 1791, the Miquel family acquired Château Cazal Viel.

Today, the vineyard represents the largest independent estate in the Saint-Chinian appellation. Cultivated with passion by Henri, and his son Laurent, an 8th generation winemaker, these poor lands give birth to great wines of the Saint-Chinian appellation and exceptional whites.

TASTING NOTES

Solas Pinot Noir is balanced, with a generous and light body. Aromas of wild strawberries and rosemary - with hints of spicy Indian tea on the finish. The palate reveals flavours of cherries, raspberries and blackberries.

PRODUCTION NOTES

Night harvest, cold prefermentation maceration for 5 to 7 days to extract a maximum of fruity aromas, fermentation up to 25-26 degrees alternating punching down and pumping over. Mostly aged in stainless steel tanks with 20% aged in barrels of 1 to 2 wines for 6 months to increase the complexity of this wine.
