A descendant of Bordeaux's famed wine merchant, Barton & Guestier, John had a vision of producing Cabernet Sauvignon that would rival the world's best. French trained winemaker Bernard Portet was selected to head the search for the perfect property from which to produce these wines.

TASTING NOTES

This Cabernet Sauvignon from the Napa Valley is full of the characteristics of this classic grape variety: blackcurrant, bramble and blueberry. It has a beautifully rich and textured taste with creamy notes of butterscotch.

Goes very well with lamb kebabs, lamb shank, duck breast with red wine sauce , grilled beef entrecote.
