John and Henrietta Goelet founded Clos Du Val in 1972. A descendant of Bordeaux's famed wine merchant, Barton & Guestier, John had a vision of producing Cabernet Sauvignon that would rival the world's best. French trained winemaker Bernard Portet was selected to head the search for the perfect property from which to produce these wines.

TASTING NOTES

The wine has deep blackcurrant aromas with a hint of clove. Displaying flavors of blueberry, toast, espresso and fresh cream, there is a long, velvety finish.

Pairs well with grilled or roasted red meats, duck and strong cheeses.
