He succumbed to the charm of the region and eventually settled there. He founded the Maison Hardy in 1863. He adopted the Gallic cockerel as the emblem of his house.

A beautiful vermilion color with amber reflections. Nose: refined and with seductive aromas of caramel, almonds, roasted walnuts, raisins and sea salt. Palate: In the mouth, there are also notes of chocolat and roasted coffee leading to a remarkably long finish.
